Below are the directions to export your animal records from AAA and Import them in to 701x.

**Step 1:** Log in to your Angus online account

[AAA Login \(angusonline.org\)](http://angusonline.org)

**Step 2:** Download a custom herd file by clicking Reports -> Interactive -> Create Custom Animal Report.

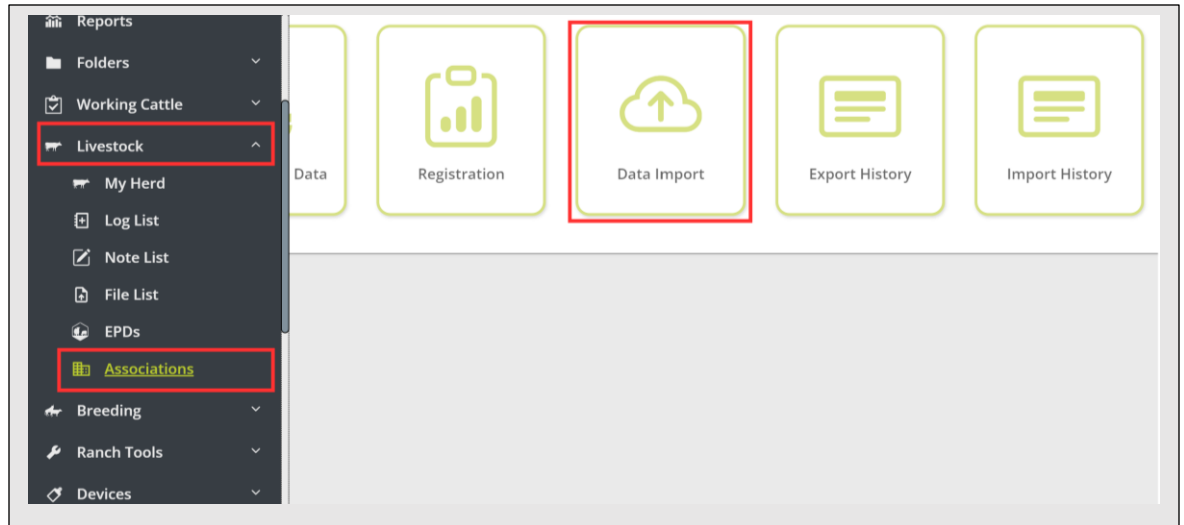
- Only adjust the settings as highlighted to the right as selecting other filters may cause the import to fail.
- Click boxes for Excel Spreadsheet, Select All Columns, Show Interim Indicators, Show Accuracies, and Show EPD/Value Percentile Ranks.

**Step 3:** Scroll to the bottom of the screen and click "Search". This will download an excel spreadsheet. Please remember the name and location within your folders that you save this excel sheet.

**Step 4:** Log in to the 701x web app at [mobile.701x.com](http://mobile.701x.com).

**Step 5:** Open navigation bar on left side of screen and click “Livestock” -> “Associations” -> “Data Import.”



**Step 6:** Choose the ranch you want animals added to as well as the association these animals are registered with.

**Step 7:** Choose the file you want to upload.  
\*\*this is the file from steps 1-3.

**Step 8:** Select how you would like animals imported and then click “yes”.

- Option 1: “Create and Update Reg. Animals” this will allow import to update data on any animals it is able to match up through unique identified such as Registration number. For the animals that don’t have a viable match in 701x, it will create them as a new animal in the system.
- Option 2: “Only Update Reg. Animals” This will only update data on animal it is able to match through unique identifiers. The rest of the animals on spreadsheet will NOT be added to 701x.
